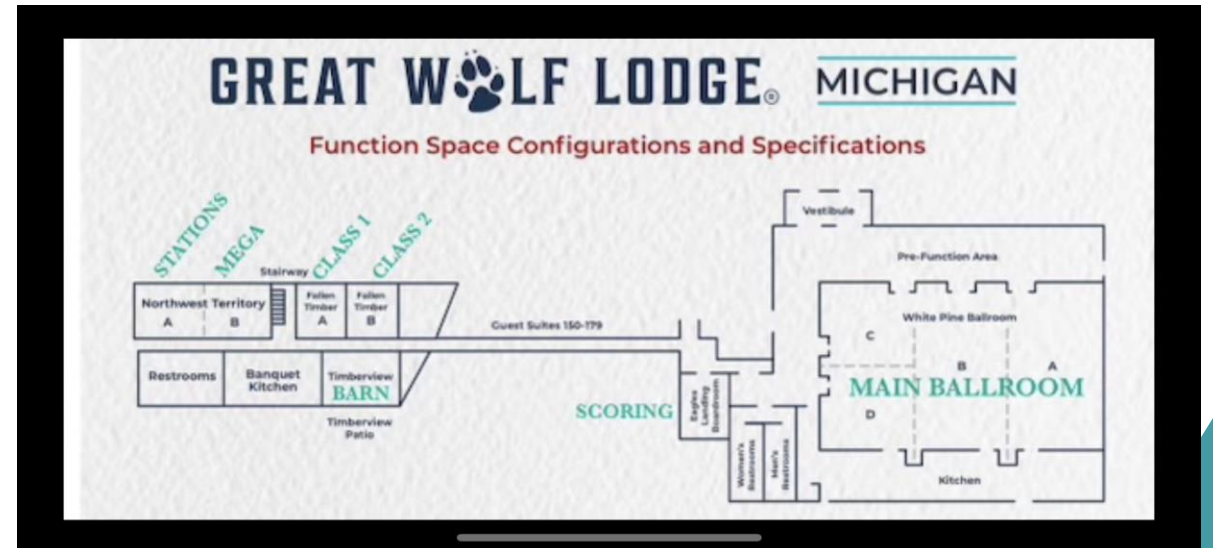

Phases of Quiz

1. **Classroom** - Q&A session done verbally with your team and a judge. Members will go one at a time and answer questions on their own. Novice D members can “confer” with their team members for half the points if they do not know the answer. This is only for NOVICE D teams, and it will not be allowed at Champs.
2. **Barn** - Members identify items found in a barn including parts of a horse, saddle, bridle, equipment used on a horse, etc. It could also include stall type scenarios such as hanging a feed bag or water bucket properly. There will be a “team” question/s in which members work together to answer questions.
3. **Stations** - In this room, members will work as a team to complete timed tasks such as organizing rally kits, assembling a bridle, identifying various equipment, working through different scenarios, etc.
4. **Mega Room** - In this room, members rotate stations on their own identifying items such as farrier tools, bits, horse colors, horse breeds, cross-country jumps, martingales, horse boots, horse feed, etc. Every year is different. There will be 5 tables to rotate through.
5. **Written Exam** - Members take a short paper/pencil exam with various questions. Members that need a reader will be provided one. There are multiple choice, true/false and fill in the blank questions. These tests come directly from the national office and are kept confidential.

Studying for Quiz Rally

What if this is my first Quiz?

First and foremost, you cannot learn everything overnight! You cannot learn everything in a month! Regardless if this is your first Quiz or your 10th, take a deep breath, this is meant to be a FUN, learning experience.

How do I study?

A fabulous place to start is the USPC website. Study materials can be found on the Pony Club IQ page, under the education heading on the front page of their website. You must be logged in to have access to this material. You will find tons of material to study here! Another great way to study, is to purchase flash cards from the USPC website. There are cards for every HM level. Questions are on the front and answers on the back.

Bonus Study Materials: Below is a link that will take you to the Shore Riders Pony Club website that put A LOT of thought and work into creating question/answer sheets for you to study. You DO NOT need to study everything. Start small and study just a few things at a time. Every Quiz is different...some materials are there and some are not. It changes year to year. HOW TO ENTER:

AGE GROUPS: Senior- 15 and over; Junior- 11-thru 14; Beginner- 10 and under

CATEGORIES:

1. 2-D (painting, drawing, printmaking, other)
2. 3-D (sculpture, ceramic, metal, other)
3. Mixed Media- (crafts, collage, other)
4. Digital- (photography, video, animation)
5. Poetry- (any type)

GUIDELINES:

- Enter more than one piece of art, however only one piece from any single medium— such as oil painting, charcoal drawing, watercolor, or digital. Craft items can be homemade or craft kits. Any style of poetry is acceptable and can be mixed with art. More than one entry of poetry can be submitted.
- Judges will be selected from volunteer adults attending Quiz Rally who have knowledge related to art.
- Winners and prizes to be announced at Quiz awards; Pick up art/poetry/digital prints at Quiz awards.
