### **General Rally Information**

Eligibility	<ul> <li>All Pony Club members in good standing may participate. All USPC, GLR and club dues paid in full.</li> <li>The DC is responsible for determining eligibility in his/her club.</li> </ul>
Teams	<ul> <li>Consists of 3 or 4 members. Each team must have a captain.</li> <li>Each team must have an official adult chaperone.</li> <li>If your club does not have enough participants to form a full team, enter your participants in as scramble members and the secretary will place them on a team.</li> </ul>
Entries	<ul> <li>Entries are due Saturday, February 8, 2025</li> <li>Incomplete entries not corrected by closing date are considered late.</li> <li>ONE person from your club should do entries and payment for your club.</li> <li>Entries are electronic at the following link: <a href="https://vicersglrponyclub.wufoo.com/forms/s15a5ckl1r7u624/">https://vicersglrponyclub.wufoo.com/forms/s15a5ckl1r7u624/</a></li> </ul>
Rules	The Quiz Rally will be run in accordance with the USPC Quiz Rulebook 2025, all addenda and the current newsletter.
Medical Armband OR Wristband	<ul> <li>Each competitor <i>must</i> wear a Medical Armband containing an original, signed Medical Card. It is the responsibility of the parent and competitor to ensure the Medical Armband contains current and correct information.</li> <li>Medical wristbands must be according to USPC policy 0128, effective 1/1/15</li> </ul>
Scramble Teams	<ul> <li>The secretary will place the scramble members on a team.</li> <li>If you know which team you would like to participate with, please send Amy Koepke an email indicating you are a scramble member with a preferred team you would like to participate with.</li> <li>If you have a full team of scramble members, you can have ONE person enter all the scramble members as a TEAM entry.</li> </ul>
Attire	<ul> <li>Pinnies will be worn.</li> <li>Collared shirt, USPC pin and neat, clean pants (khaki preferred). Belt if pants have belt loops; belt optional for UR-D1. Footwear may reflect horseless barn (paddock boots not required).</li> <li>Team themes are BACK! Feel free to be creative with costumes and/or matching accessories!</li> </ul>

Cancellations/ Refunds	<ul> <li>After the closing date, a 50% refund will be issued only if one of the following is provided: 1) Medical certificate signed by a physician indicating competitor's ill health; 2) letter from the DC in the case of unavoidable circumstances.</li> <li>In all other cases, no refund for cancellations will be given after the closing date.</li> </ul>
Meals	<ul> <li>Lunch will be included in the entry fee for members and volunteers.</li> <li>The GWL offers a variety of restaurants within the facility, plan ahead for a timely meal.</li> <li>Other places close to eat are Panera, Chick-fil-A, Olive Garden, Firehouse Subs, Tropical Smoothie, Red Lobster, Little Caesars, McDonalds, Burger King, Applebees, and MANY others including non-chain restaurants.</li> </ul>
Volunteers	<ul> <li>Each team must provide a chaperone.</li> <li>Each team must also provide 1 volunteer per member. All may not be used, however they need to be available.</li> </ul>

Written Test	Tests are written annually by USPC quiz committee, not the GLR or the organizer. Reading assistance is available.	No
Classroom	Oral questions are asked of each competitor that are written by the USPC quiz committee, not the GLR or organizer.	Yes, must be in room at beginning of phase and stay for entire session. No talking, phones, study material, or recording.
Barn	Teams demonstrate HM skills. Life sized model horse.	No
Stations	Teams work together to answer hands-on questions. At least 5 questions.	No
Mega Room	Individual questions. Typically groups of items that must be identified. Reading assistance allowed.	No

## Quiz Rally March 8, 2025 QUALIFYING DIVISIONS

#### Anyone trying to qualify for Championships must compete in the correct division.

Pony Club age is as of January 1 of current year. Any competitor over the age of 10 can be considered for Championships in a Championship year. Divisions are the HM certification level at closing date. If competitor has certified after closing date, the old HM level is their competition level.

<b>Division</b>	Division Description	Age
Novice D	Unrated-D3	11 years old or less as of 1/1/25
<mark>Junior D</mark>	Unrated-D3	12-17 years old as of 1/1/25
Senior D	Unrated-D3	18+ years old as of 1/1/25
<mark>C/HB</mark>	C1-HB, H	All ages

- Teams compete against other teams in their division by moving through each phase. The teams are grouped in groups of 3-5 teams and move through the phases together. These are called rotation groups.
- The schedule is planned to allow each group the same amount of time in each phase, however, some rotation groups may take longer than others in a phase or one phase may take longer. Breaks are scheduled to attempt to bring all teams to end at approximately the same time. All teams will move through all phases by the end of competition.
- Written Test, Classroom, and two of the three phases of Barn, Mega Room, and Stations are required by USPC to be a championships qualifying rally, however this is not a qualifying year.

#### "Intro D" Competitor

For those Unrated/D1 AND 10 years old or younger, there is a competition option where competitors have beginner-friendly questions. There are less total points possible, but more points attainable for the new competitor, compared to the regular Novice D questions. Intro D participants are included in Novice D teams. A full team of Intro participates is permitted, but we encourage you to spread them out on your Novice teams.

AGE GROUPS: Senior- 15 and over; Junior- 11-thru 14; Beginner- 10 and under

- **CATEGORIES:** 1. 2-D (painting, drawing, printmaking, other)
  - 2. 3-D (sculpture, ceramic, metal, other)
  - 3. Mixed Media- (crafts, collage, other)
  - 4. Digital- (photography, video, animation)
  - 5. Poetry- (any type)

#### **GUIDELINES:**

- Enter more than one piece of art, however only one piece from any single medium—such as oil painting, charcoal drawing, watercolor, or digital. Craft items can be homemade or craft kits. Any style of poetry is acceptable and can be mixed with art. More than one entry of poetry can be submitted.
  - Judges will be selected from volunteer adults attending Quiz Rally who have knowledge related to art.
  - Winners and prizes to be announced at Quiz awards; Pick up art/poetry/digital prints at Quiz awards.
