

USPC Festival Championships Registration

The official USPC registration for Festival

Championships opens on May 1st. This is why it is important to get your intention forms into Lori Page before then, so that I can approve your intention and you can proceed with your registration online with USPC.

USPC REGISTRATION DATES

Opening Date: Monday, May 1, 2024

Closing Date: June 24, 2024 (This is the day after Mega Rally)

Qualification Period: April 1, 2023 - June 23, 2024







USPC Festival Education Entries

Festival Education entries are separate from Championship entries. You can participate in Festival

Education WITHOUT participating in Champs. Please visit the USPC website for full details!



Festival Education

Mounted Education

Open to any member at a D-2 riding certification level and above who are at least 10 years old. Members that register for mounted education can choose from 2 mounted clinics a day taught by top U.S. equestrians. Includes unlimited unmounted educational opportunities.



Unmounted Education



Participants of any age or certification level may register for unmounted education covering information from the D level to the H-A level (however, at least 8 years old is recommended). Participants will have unlimited access to all unmounted education and may audit mounted clinics.

D Camp

Pony Club members up to the D-2 level between the ages of 6 and 12 who are NOT qualified for Championships will learn basic riding skills, play games, work towards their next certification, and have lots of fun!


This will be a qualifying rally for Champs! More detailed information coming SOON!


