(flat or jump)

Stalls are:

- Permanent roof structure with temporary stall panels for stall walls; same stall panels you see in tent stabling.
- Dirt floors
- Secure doors
- Electricity available
- 2-3 bags of shavings for start & extra 1-2 bags is recommended

Tack Boxes & saddle rack can be left by your stall.

It MUST stay neat and tidy in the overhang areas by your stalls; the area right by your stall..

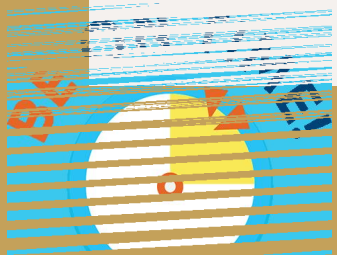
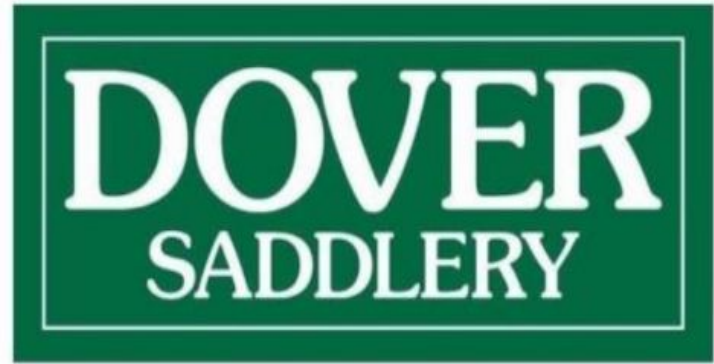
