- Reviewed new leadership, board roles. Background check and training requirements are essential and nonnegotiable. Leadership requirements must be completed by 3/31 in order to have compliance or new leadership must be.
- O USPC Insurance required to be pulled for every single date you have a mounted activity (if a horse isn't involved at unmounted)! You must populate the actual dates of the actual. Club leadership is liable if an issue happens and insurance isn't in effect. If you are meeting at a location like Panera where they have insurance. If the meeting is in the barn at a home, have the pony club insurance pulled but entire lesson program isn't covered, just the insured activity. Still need to sign a facility's release acknowledging them as insured.

## • <u>Treasurer</u> (Melynda Ziehm)

- Budgeted a loss and under by about \$63. For 2023 we are starting sound.
- o Prospective loss for this year is \$80 (essentially flat). Hoping to grow to prepare for higher expenses next year due to festival.
- Collected all but \$280 of regional dues! Thanks to everyone.
- o Safe sport & compliance—only 2 members that are noncompliant.
- Really pleased compared to last year. Reminder: if people are coming of age soon, you can do the SafeSport training before you turn 18.
- AmazonSmile has discontinued their program.
- 77% of clubs are complete with year end tasks for 2022.
  5 clubs have financial peer reviews outstanding.
- Reminder: 990 must be filed by May 15. Enter your budgets for the year. Protip: get the W9 in advance if you know you'll be paying someone over \$600 during the year. Make sure those categories align in the CFRS with 1099 payments.
