Wow! This winter has been brutal. It's beautiful, but hard on the humans taking care of horses and other livestock. Spring is just around the corner, so hang in there!





We are working on securing a date and location for a late summer/fall Mega Rally. Please stay tuned! We need volunteers to help organize the rally!




